Topic: Introduction to Praise

PRAISE is an outward expression of rejoicing, joy, liberty, hope, victory, adoration, tears and thanksgiving in the Lord not based on feeling that gives glory he God and edifies the body of Christ.

I. What is Praise

- a. To extol, uplift, magnify, laud, rejoice with physical & vocal adoration in the Lord

- b. To express joy, adoration, hope, liberty, and all manner of Godly fruit in edifying manifestations in the Lord Acts 3:8-9, II Sam 6:23, 1 Cor 14:12/40, Luke 2:13/20 Acts 2:47, Ps 119:164, Ps 50:23, Gal 5:22, Rom 14:17, Rev 19:5, Ps 96:11-12, Ps 98:7-8, Is 55:12

- d. When going through trials & tribulations
