There are many who hold to the doctrine of "Once Saved Always Saved". Even though we may not agree, we must maintain fellowship and spiritual kinship with our fellow believers. This lesson is not intended to cause any division, consequently, this lesson is to present sagacious scriptural dialogue on both sides of "Once Saved Always Saved".

I. God is longsuffering but not all suffering (does not condone/tolerate sin, but may be gracious):

- a - longsuffering - Ps 103:8-13, Ps 145:8, II Pet 3:9, Jonah 3:5-10, Lam 3:22-23, Matt 18:14
- b - God always gives space to repent - Gen 3:9-14, Gen 4:6-7, Rev 2:5, Rev 2:16, Rev 2:21-22
- c - Canaanites given approx. 400 years to repent while Israel is approx. 400 years in Egyptian bondage - Gen 15:9-16, Ex 12:40-41, Deut 7:1-6
- d - Sodom and Gomorra - Gen 18:20-33, Gen 19

V. Choice to revert to old lifestyle (not 3 strikes your out but change in love, trust) = loss of salvation:

- Gal 5:19-21, I John 3:4/8/9, Heb 3:12-13, Heb 6:1-9, Heb 10:26-31, Galatians/Demas/Solomon
- 1st stage = Spiritual Separation from God & Believers - Is 59:1-2, Is 66:18, I Cor 5:9-13, Jam 1:15
- 2nd stage = Warnings with Chastisement - II Sam 12, I Kings 11:9, Heb 12:5-11
- 3rd stage = Hardening, Blindness - Heb 3:12-13, Exodus 8:18-19
- 4th stage = Demise to Reprobate Mind through Continued Rejection - Rom 1:21-28
- 5th stage = Worldly Life is Embraced from the Heart - Rom 1:29-32, Gal 5:19-21, I John 3:4/8/9, Matt 6:21, Matt 6:24, I John 2:15-17, James 4:4

(These stages are not humanly dogmatic nor time sensitive but rather *Divinely Sovereign* and *Providential*)
