(4 "R" warfare process + 6 "P" warfare process + continuous circle of action)

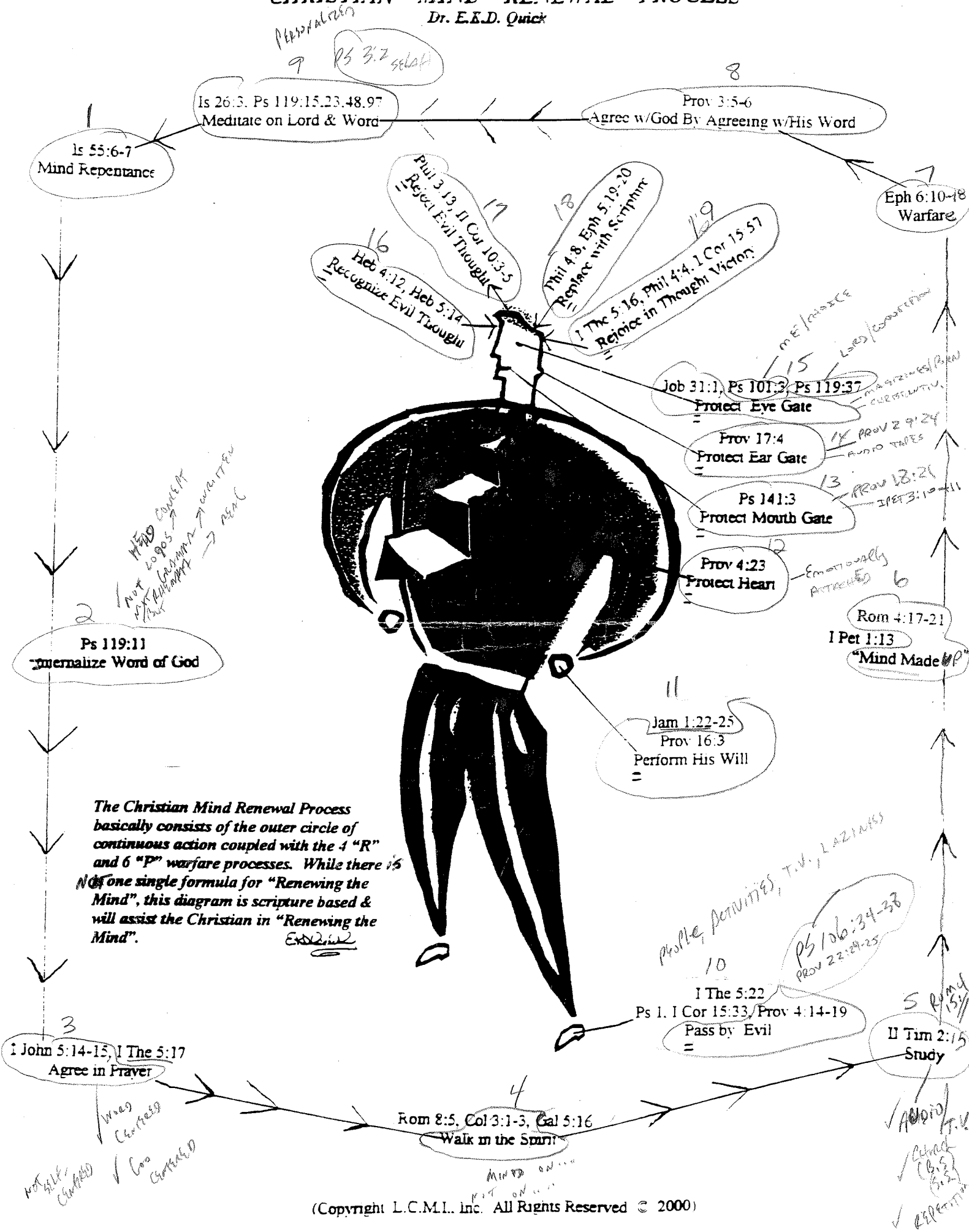
