- (1) Hope, Comfort, Admonition, Perfection.. Rom 15:4, Neh 8, Deut 6:8-9, I Cor 10:11, II Tim 3:16-17. *Direction/Guide, WARN, PUT AT EASE, EXPECTATION, LOVE, PROMISE TO, UNDESIRE, IT WILL HAPPEN*
- (2) Spiritual discernment.. Heb 5:13-14, Ps 119:99-100. *EXAMPLES, WARN, MEDIATE CONSTANTLY*
- (3) Full Knowledge.. Luke 1:1-4, Jn 5:39, Lk 24:27/44. *WRITE FOR TO MISAPPLIES*
- (4) Used in warfare... Eph 6:17, Matt 4:1-4, Heb 4:12 - MOTIVE, Heb 5:13-14, II Cor 10:4-5, Lk 4:1-13. *(promise) (sovereign/word)*

Salvation... Rom 10:9-10, Acts 16:31, Jn 3:15-18, II Chn 7:14, Ps 19:7-11, Jam 1:18/21, I Pt 1:23. *Acts 18:26*

Prosperity/Provision... Matt 6:33, Duet 8:18, Jn 10:10, Ps 23:1/Ps 84:11, Phil 4:19, Lk 12:32. *Josh 1:8, Duet 28*

Restoration... I Sam 30:1-19, Job 42:10. *Also Duet 28, Acts 20: 32, 37*

Prayer... Jn 15:7, I Jn 5:14-15, I Jn 3:22. *Agree w/...*

Purifies the life of the believer... Ps 119:9, John 15:3, John 17:17, I Pet 1:22, Neh 8, II Chn 34:14-21/29-33, Ps 119:11, Ps 119:130, Eph 5:26, Jam 1:18/21, I Pet 1:23. *IE after Joshua, CALLS US OUT OF... INTO... HEB 4:12*

Must feed the spiritual man daily... Matt 4:4, II Tim 2:15. *IF THE 5:23, WE ARE SPIRITUAL SUBJECTS, IE OF CORN VS. SPIRITUAL MANNA, "I HAVE TO EAT" - WHAT ABOUT MIND?*

Searched diligently & objectively... Jn 5:39, Acts 17:11. *PS 119:10, PS 119:16, IE of CORN VS. SPIRITUAL MANNA, "I HAVE TO EAT" - WHAT ABOUT MIND?, IE School BIBLE*

Meditate constantly... Josh 1:8, Ps 1:2, Ps 119:15/97/99. *PS 119:10, PS 119:16, AT MOUNTAIN... AT 11, "IE"...*

Spoken at circumstances... Is 55:11, Jer 1:12, Mk 11:23, Matt 8:8. *ANSWER TO, PERSONAL LIFE, "NOT JUST DATA"*

- (1) Bible should be read with the attitude of a "love letter" from God to believer. *NOT JUST DATA, RECEIVES AS APPLIED LOVE*
- (2) Book of Ephesians should be starting book for new believers... *1 - PROMISES, 2 - BEHOLD & PRAISE, 3 - CHURCH & SPIRIT, 4 - AFTER/WALK (WOT), 5 - WALK/WIVES/HUSBANDS*
- (3) Book of Ephesians should be book that mature Christians "master" first... *FAMILIAR W/ WALK... QUOTE/APPLY (CAUSE OF ALL BOOK ASPECTS)*
- (4) Always agree with God by agreeing with God's Word. *OVER, AMEN, BATTLE/ENTER*
