Water baptism is a sacrament of the new testament experience that publicly displays our inward conversion toward the Lord Jesus Christ. Water baptism is necessary as an act of obedience but not "necessarily" as an act of salvation.

Water baptism symbolizes Christ's death, burial and resurrection. Thus, water baptism publicly identifies the old man being dead to sin, the old man buried with Christ and the new man raised in newness of life and alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord (Romans 6:3-11) Colossians 2:12)
